

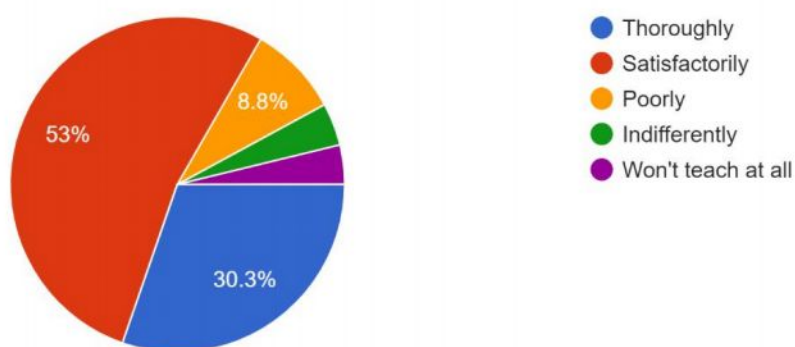
Durga Mahavidyalaya is dedicated to fostering the academic growth of its students by continuously enhancing the teaching and learning process. At the end of each academic year, the institution collects student feedback to identify areas for improvement and implements necessary changes accordingly.


A Student Satisfaction Survey focusing on teaching, learning, and evaluation was conducted among the students via various WhatsApp groups. A Google Form with twenty multiple-choice questions designed to cover a broad spectrum of aspects related to the teaching and learning process was shared with the students to gather their perceptions. All questions were mandatory, with five response options provided for each, requiring students to select the most appropriate one. The questionnaire primarily included items recommended by NAAC.

A total of 2026 students participated in the survey. Based on their responses, the institution has undertaken relevant quality enhancement initiatives in the identified areas. Below is a report summarizing the feedback received from the students, as per the questionnaire shared by the college.

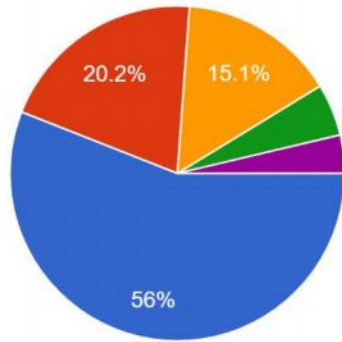

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How well were the teachers able to communicate?

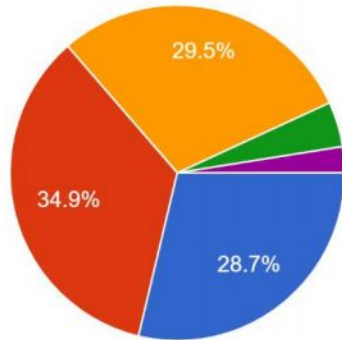

The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as

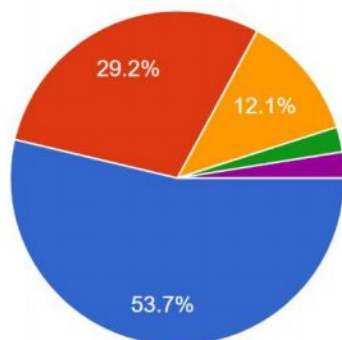

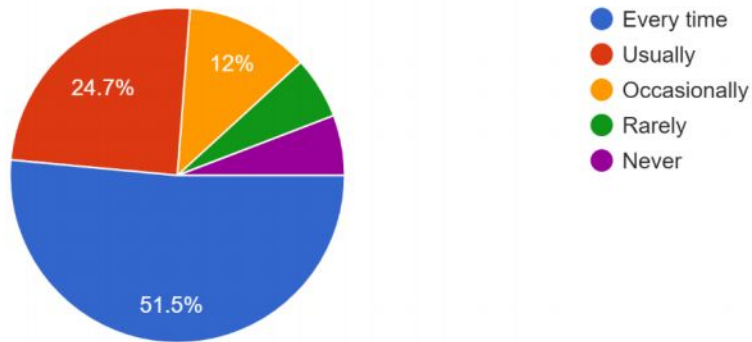

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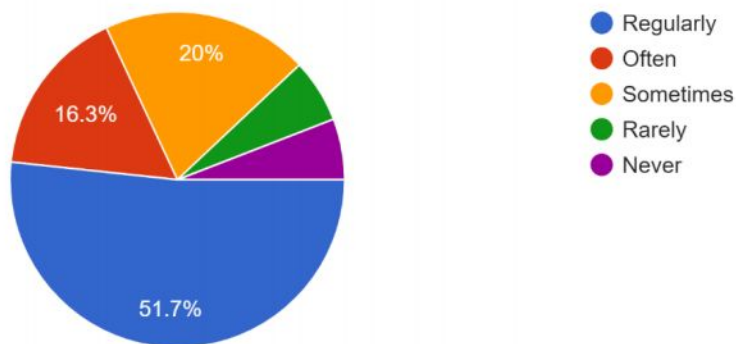
Was your performance in assignments/internal examinations discussed with you?

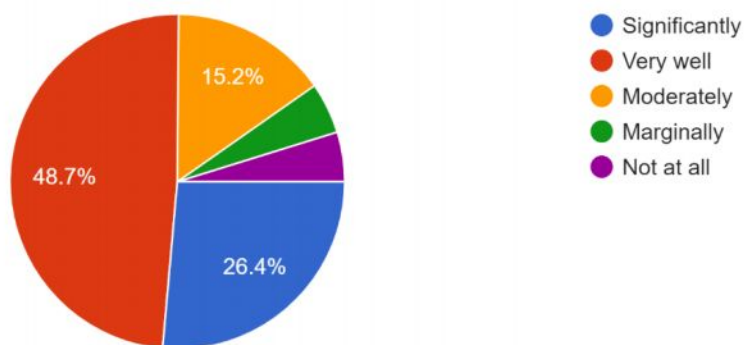

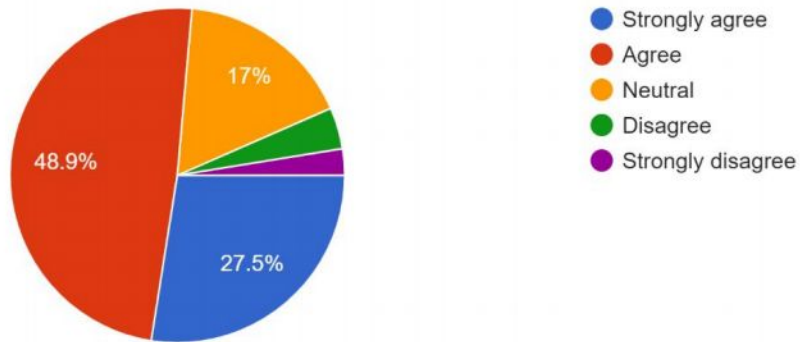

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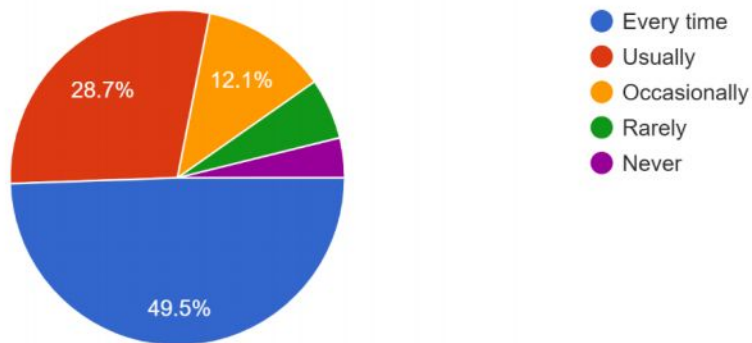

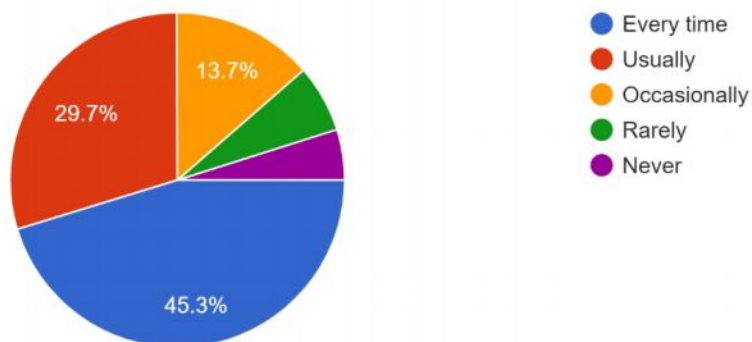



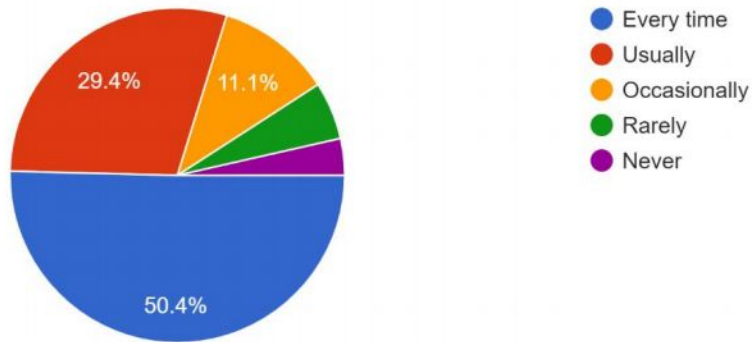

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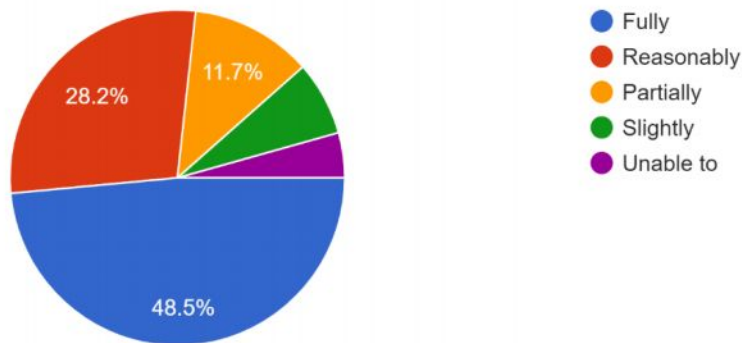

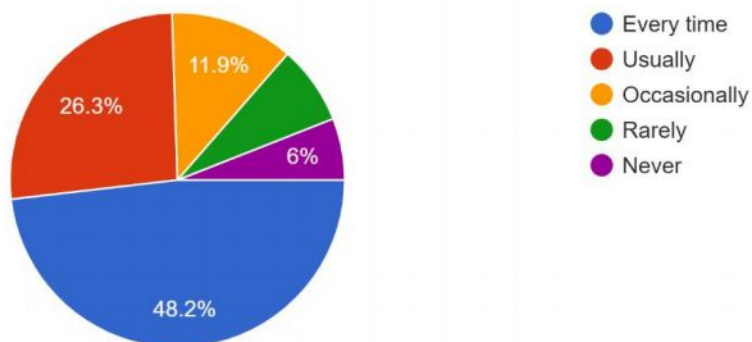



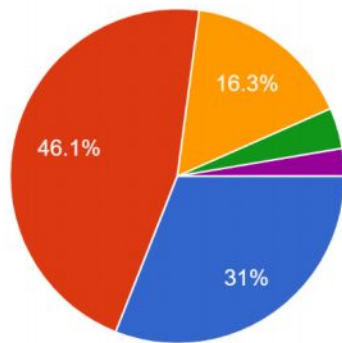

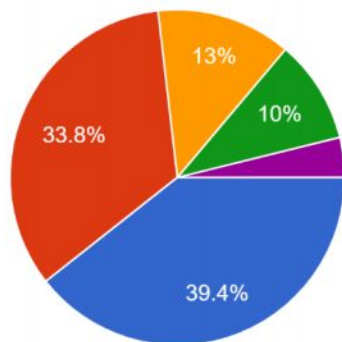

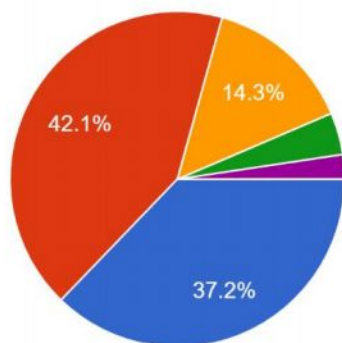

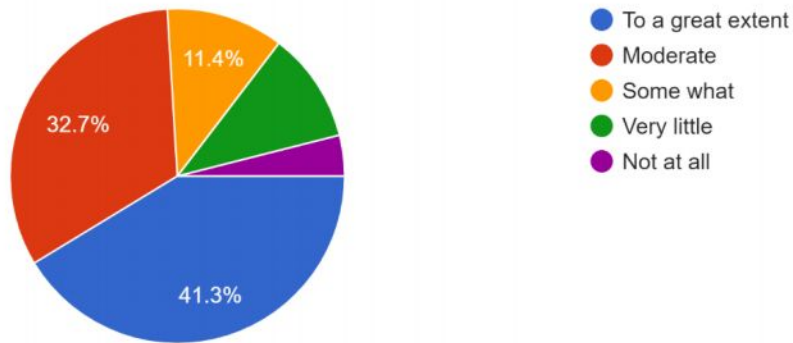

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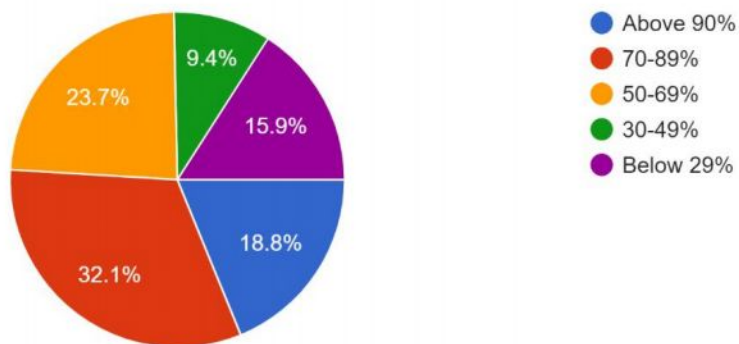

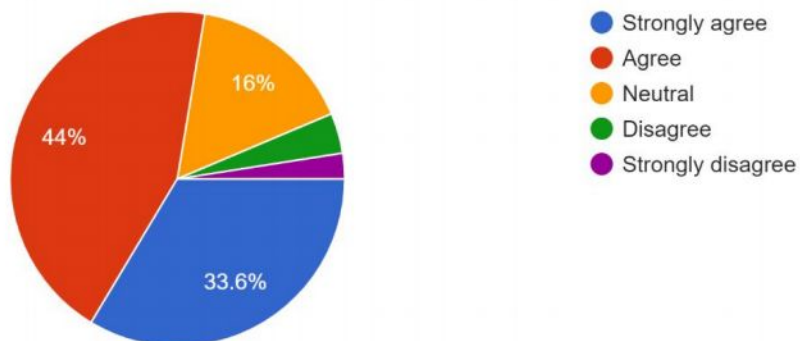
What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching?





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Based on the responses received, the majority of students have indicated that the teaching and learning process is satisfactory. They appreciate the diverse opportunities provided to engage in both academic and extracurricular activities. The feedback also reflects a high level of satisfaction, with students expressing that the institution has offered them an outstanding platform for learning. A detailed question-wise summary of the students' responses is presented in the table below:

S.No	Question	Response gathered
1	How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?	The responses indicate that in most classes, over 70% of the syllabus has been completed. The faculty members ensure and make certain that 100% syllabus completion is achieved. The Head of Departments (HODs) have been tasked with monitoring syllabus coverage.
2	How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?	The responses indicate that most teachers are well-prepared for their classes, utilizing unit plans, notes, ICT, question banks, and other resources.
3	How well were the teachers able to communicate?	The majority of students are satisfied with the communication skills of our teachers. A bilingual approach is adopted in the classroom, with communication in both English and Hindi, ensuring that all students can effectively grasp the concepts.
4	The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as	Students are satisfied with the teaching approach. To engage different types of learners, teachers incorporate a variety of strategies and techniques into their daily classes.
5	Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers	Teachers maintain complete fairness in the internal evaluation process, and the majority of students are satisfied with it.

Students are highly satisfied as teachers actively discuss their performance in assignments and internal examinations, providing guidance on improving their grades. Additional efforts are made for low scorers, including arranging remedial classes.
