## ACTION TAKEN BASED ON CURRICULUM RELATED FEEDBACK

### STUDENTS'

Curriculum feedback is an important exercise conducted by the college. Curriculum Feedback Survey forms for all stakeholders has been designed by the Feedback Committee to essentially capture the various aspects of curriculum design and implementation. It was taken in a multiple-choice question format via Google form. The forms were circulated amongst the stakeholders - students (undergraduate and postgraduate level), alumni and teachers across all disciplines offered by the college.

For the academic year 2022- 2023, students' feedback was sought from around **1192** students about the curriculum and teaching learning process. Based on the online survey conducted among the students at the end of the academic year, it was found that majority of the student population agreed that the syllabus was very challenging and the allocation of credits was appropriate in relation to the level of course work. Students were of the view that the curriculum of the college at U.G and P.G level were adequately designed to cater to the needs of the time. It can be concluded that the primary stakeholders strongly agree to the fact that the college was effective in implementing the curriculum in the best possible way. Only very few percentage of students have had concerns on aspects like relevance and adequateness of the curriculum in real life, utility and competitive examination.

As the college is an affiliated one, hence bound to follow syllabi prescribed by parent body. Many of the faculties are Chairperson and Members of Board of Studies in the parent body. As a result, the feedback analysis report is conveyed to them to put before the meeting of Board of Studies.

At the college level, a meeting of the academic was held and feedback analysis report was discussed. Head of the Departments were asked to organize workshops, Lecture series, Add On courses relating to these issues. More Value-added/Certificate and Skill oriented courses have been included as a part of curriculum enrichment.




## ALUMNI


