## Academic Year 2022-2023

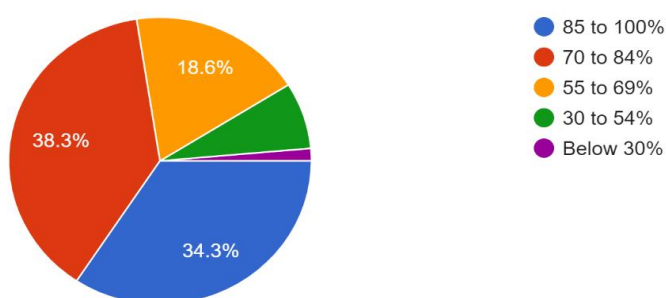

A google form comprising of twenty multiple choice questions covering a wide range of domains involved in the teaching learning process was shared with the students in order to know their perception on various aspects of teaching learning process. All the questions were to be compulsorily attempted. Each question had five responses and the student had to choose the most appropriate one. The survey included majorly the questionnaires recommended by NAAC.

Total of 1001 students responded to the survey and based on the responses gathered from the student's necessary quality enhancement initiatives in the required areas have been taken by the institution. 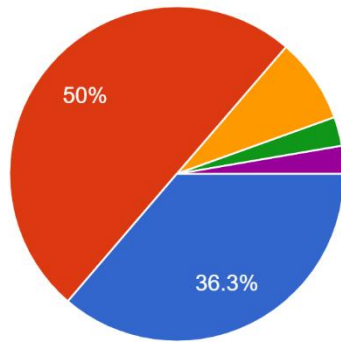
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

### How well did the teachers prepare for the classes ?

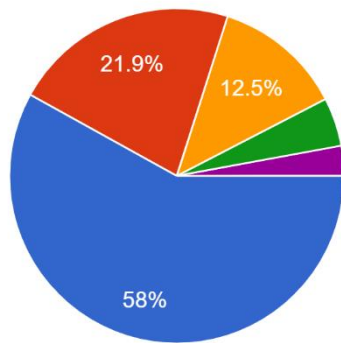

### How well were the teachers able to communicate ?

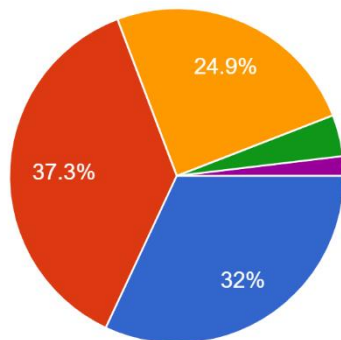

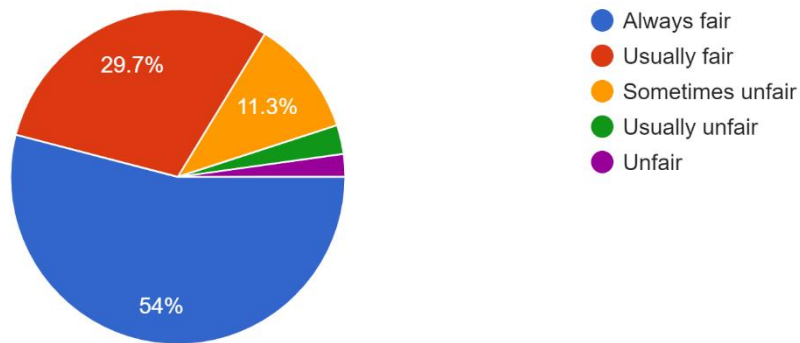

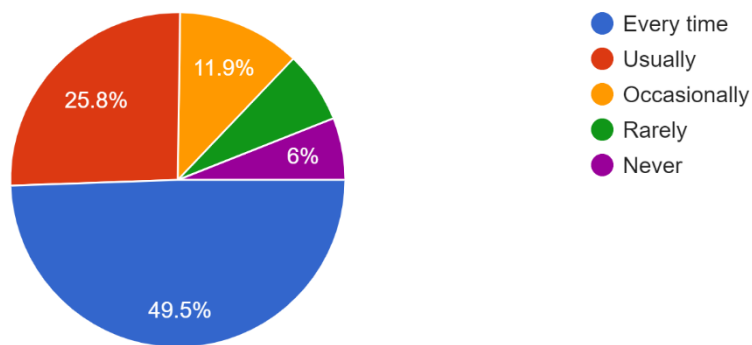
### Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

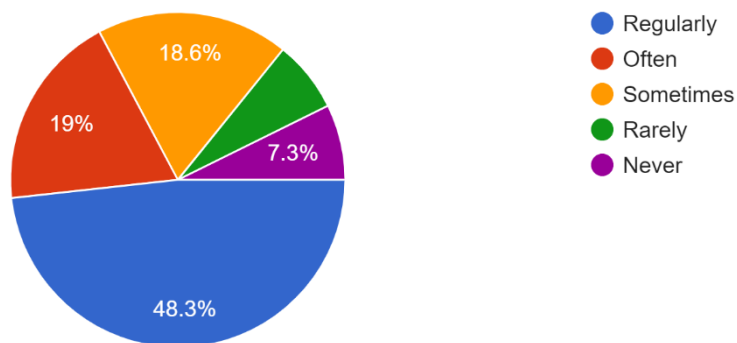

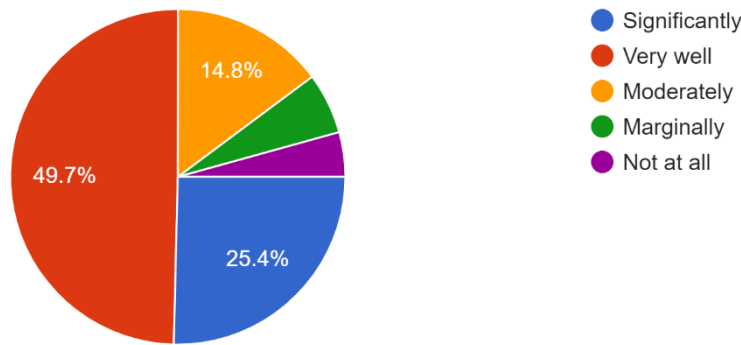

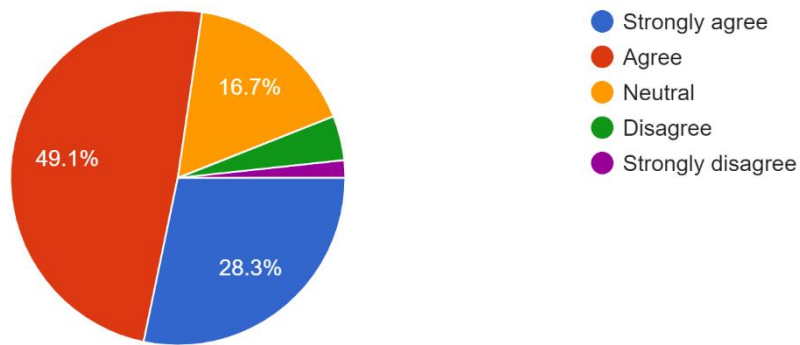

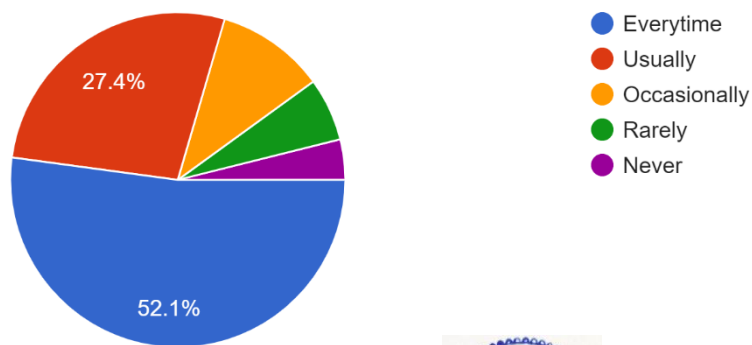

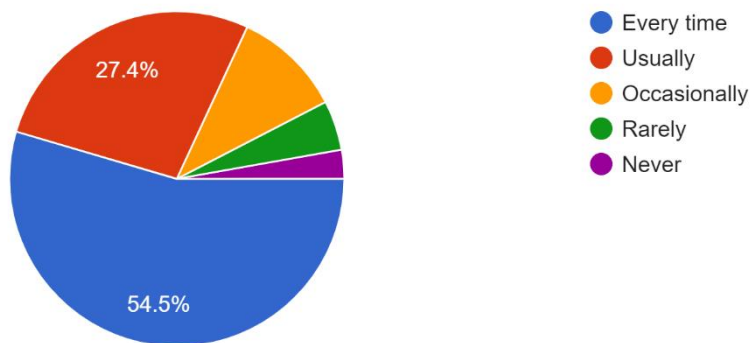
Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.

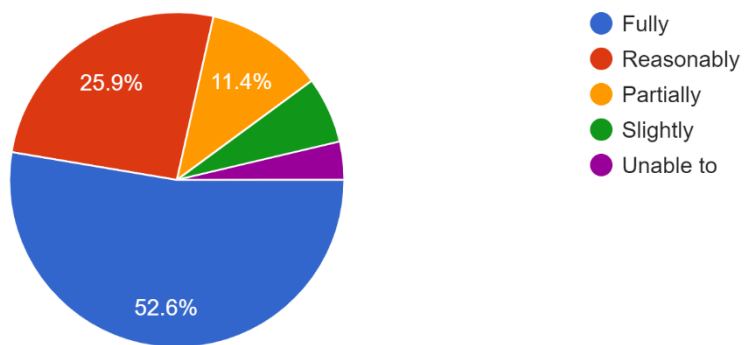
The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

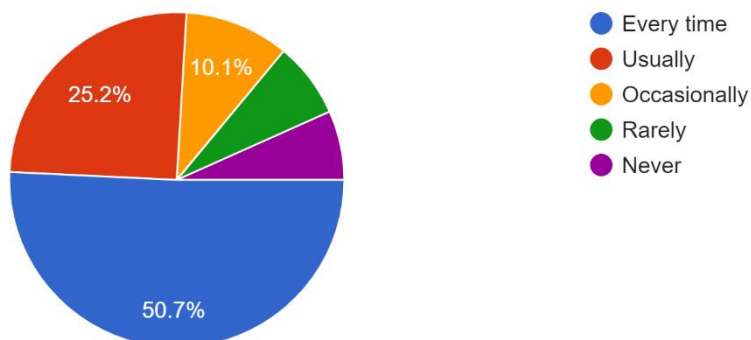
The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

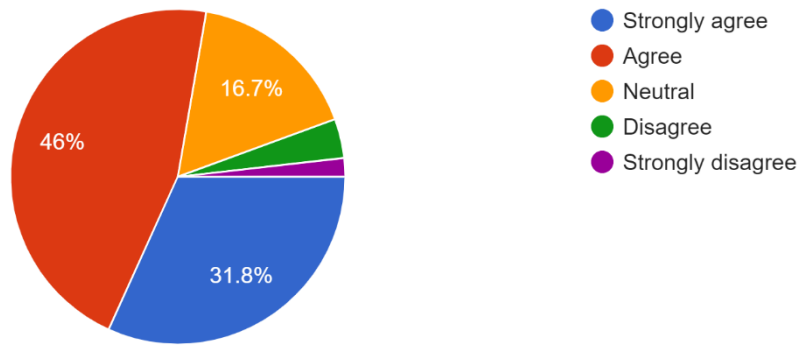
Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

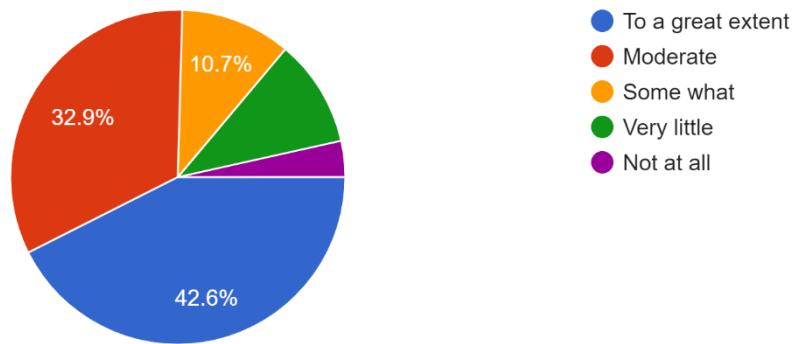

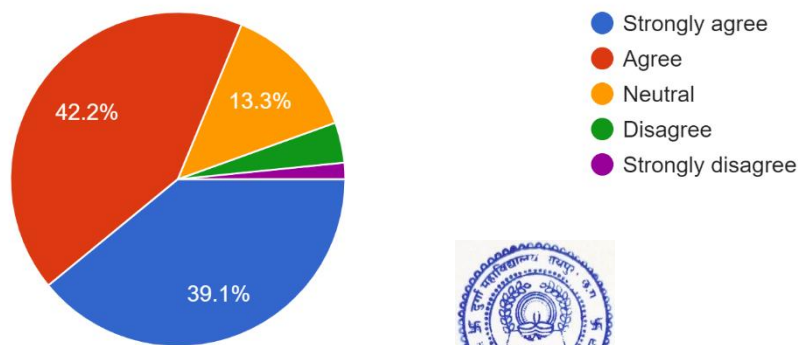

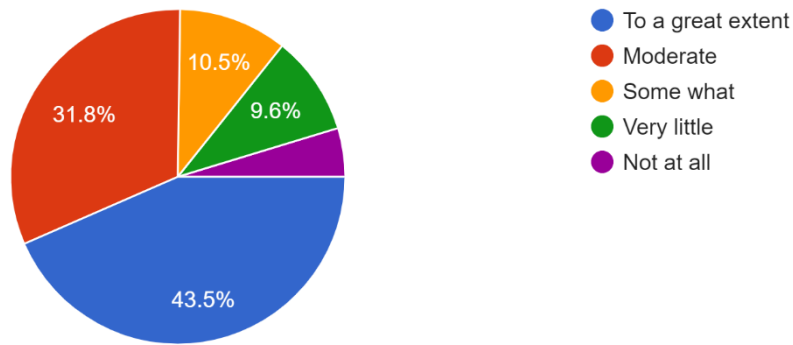

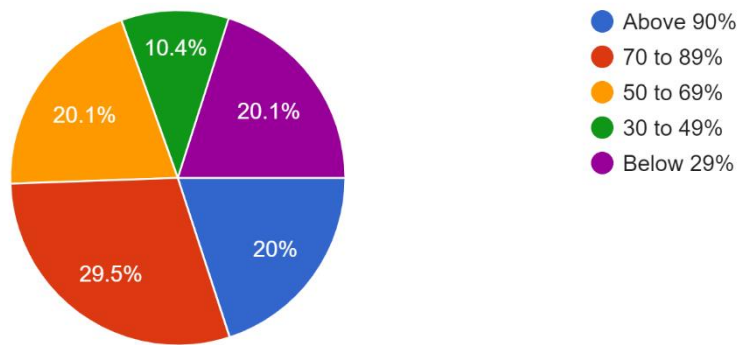

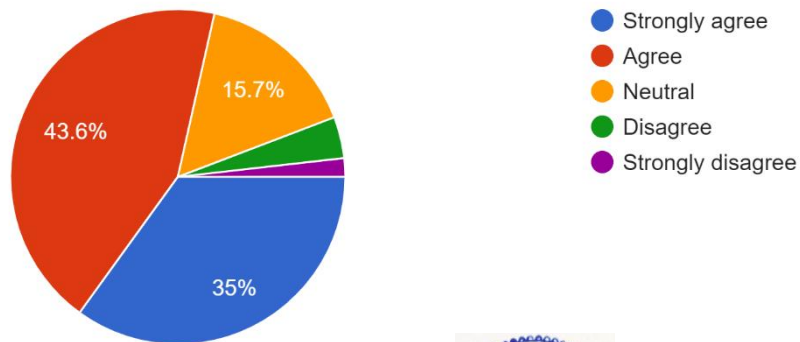
What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching.

The question wise summary of the responses gathered from the students is in the table below:

S.No	Question	Response gathered
1	How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?	The responses show that in most of the classes more than 80% of the syllabus is covered. However, all the faculty members are advised to ensure cent percent syllabus completion. HODs have been given the responsibility to review syllabus coverage every month.
2	How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?	The responses show that most of the teachers prepare quite well for the classes by preparing unit plans, study Material, question bank etc.
3	How well were the teachers able to communicate?	Most of the students are satisfied with the communication skills of our teachers. Teachers use bilingual method in the classroom. Communication in both English as well as Hindi language is encouraged to ensure that all students understand the concepts.
4	The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as	Students are satisfied with the approach of teaching. In order to involve all the different types of learners in the class, teachers use variety of strategies and techniques in the day-to-day classes.
5	Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers	Teachers ensure fairness in the internal evaluation process and most students are satisfied with this.
6	Was your performance in assignments/internal examinations discussed with you? 	Students are very much satisfied with this as teachers make all the efforts to discuss students' performance in assignments and internal examinations and guide them on ways to improve their grades. Extra effort is taken for low scorers and remedial classes are also arranged for them.

Mandatory internships programs are held for the students of Education and students of other practical subjects and frequent field visits are also organized for practical learning. Majority of the students are satisfied with this aspect.
